4 Strategic Questions to Ask Yourself when looking at the diagrams

- 1. What does the figure represent?
- 2. What do the labels tell you?
- 3. What are the units of measurement?
- 4. What are the patterns in the data?

3 Step Strategy

- 1. Highlight key words in the question.
- 2.Analyze the figure(s) by asking yourself the 4 strategic questions.
- 3. Find all questions about the figure and answer those first.

- The figures are more important than the text
- Refer back to the figures often. Do not try to answer questions based on memory.
- You don't have to understand everything about a passage.

- You get points by answering the questions, not by understanding every scientific fact in the passage.
- Don't get caught up on technical terms.
- Watch your time. Don't spend too much of it on one question.
